

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

✓ Affirmative

 + **be** + verb+ing

She **is reading** a book now.

✗ Negative

 + **be** + **not** + verb+ing

She **isn't reading** a book now.

? Question

(When
What
Where) + **be** +  + verb+ing ?

Is she **reading** a book now? Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

Time expressions:

always, at the moment, now, right now, tomorrow, tonight, ...

Remember

I am we are
you are you are
he/she/it is they are



Tips!

- **e - e**
take -taking but dyeing
- **ie - y**
lie - lying
- **double consonant**
running

USE IT FOR:

- actions happening now
I'm studying English at the moment.
- temporary situations
I'm living in Paris now.
- annoying habits – with always
You're always losing your keys.
- fixed arrangements in the near future
I'm flying to London next week.

Stative Verbs

Some verbs don't have continuous forms:
believe, hate, have (possess), know, like, love,
need, remember, understand, want
